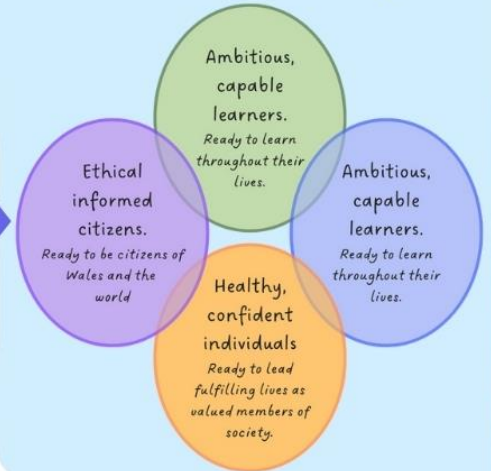

Invasion

There is an invasion coming. We will learn about aspects of everyday life in post-Roman times, understand why the Romans are leaving and who is going to replace them! We will look at a timeline for key invasions, including that of the Vikings! This half term we are hoping to create Viking shields and look into the fabulous design of Long ships. We will enhance our understanding of what life was like in Britain at this time, including the life of Viking and Anglo-Saxon children. We will study maps of the Britain and how it was split up into different kingdoms. We will look at the social structure of Viking life and make comparisons to life today. We will follow our own interests and complete work that is fun and challenging. The children will have the opportunity to actively plan for and develop future learning opportunities. They will have time to reflect upon what they have learnt and how they have learnt.

We will aim to listen to each pupil reading individually and within Guided Group Reading during the week. Books will be changed during the week if we feel that the pupils are ready to move on. Pupils will also be allocated digital books and maths tasks on Active Learn. Diolch for your continued support.
