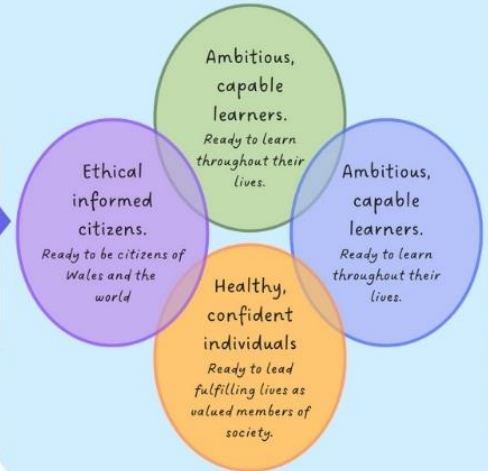

Context for Learning: A Child's War (World War II)

We will begin our year by reading parts of Roald Dahl *Going Solo* which introduces the children to the RAF and the part they played in World War II which leads us on to our main context 'A Child's War'. This context begins with a trip to the Brecon Regimental War Museum dressed as evacuees followed by exploring the 'white hat/het gwyn' facts about WWII: learning about the causes of the war, key events, propaganda, important vocabulary and 'Operation Pied Piper'. After this research, the class will choose, through 'Pupil Planning', the areas of the War they would like to explore further. We will develop our literacy skills through writing a newspaper report about the outbreak of war, writing as evacuees, describing an air raid and exploring the 'red hat/het coch' emotions of the war in poetry. Through mathematical tasks, we will explore what rationing truly meant for the British people and investigate air resistance through scientific investigations. We will use our 'green hat/het gwyrdd' to investigate artefacts and represent our learning in a fun and creative way. This project teaches children about the causes, events and consequences of the First and Second World Wars, the influence of new inventions on warfare, how life in Great Britain was affected and the legacy of the wars in the post-war period. Our RVE topic: Special Leaders, links to the Rights of a Child: Article 14 The right to practise your own religion and beliefs.

We will be preparing and performing our Christmas concert and the children will also take part in the Christmas Enterprise project.
