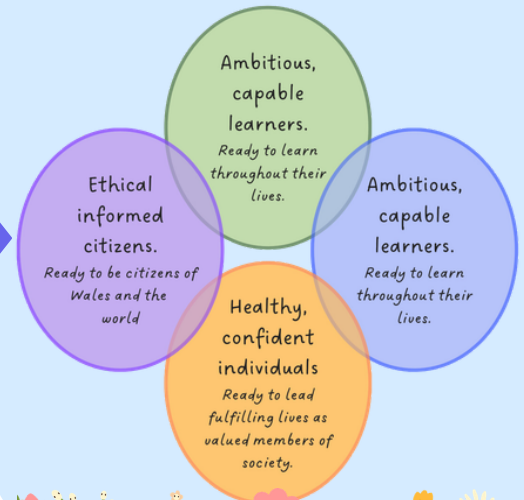
### Class Information Spring Term

#### Our Four Core Purposes



For the summer term, our topic is "Scream Machines". This topic will take the children on an exciting journey into the world of theme parks and rollercoasters. The topic brings together problem-solving, teamwork, creativity and critical thinking, helping children apply their learning to real-life contexts in an engaging and memorable way.

- Mathematical and Numeracy skills will be developed as pupils measure, calculate speed, test designs and think about safety.
- Learners will strengthen their literacy, language and communication skills through reading, writing and speaking. The children will be writing imaginatively, including creating their own leaflets to encourage visitors to attend their theme park.
- The children will explore the science behind thrilling rides, investigating forces, motion, energy and simple mechanisms such as pulleys, cams and pendulums through hands-on investigations and model making. They will design their own theme parks, using digital tools to map ideas and present designs, developing creativity and digital skills.
- Humanty skills will be developed through learning how theme parks are shaped by human choices and decisions. They will consider how businesses affect communities, jobs and the environment, helping them understand responsibility, fairness and the impact people have on the world around them.
- The children will enhance their Expressive Arts skills by using their imagination to design their own rollercoasters.
- To learn about their Healht and Wellbeing the children will reflect on how excitement and fear affects our bodies and minds, thinking about resilience, teamwork and staying safe in challenging and extreme environments. The children will also take part in age-appropriate discussions about friendships and growing up, helping them understand physical changes, respectful relationships, emotional wellbeing and how to build confidence as they develop.

#### During the week:

- PE will be every Wednesday and Friday. Kit to be worn to school. Most activities will be taken outdoors, weather permitting.
- Homework will be sent out every Friday to be completed and handed in the following Thursday. If you wish to share your work with your teacher you can upload via Google Classroom or hand it in.
