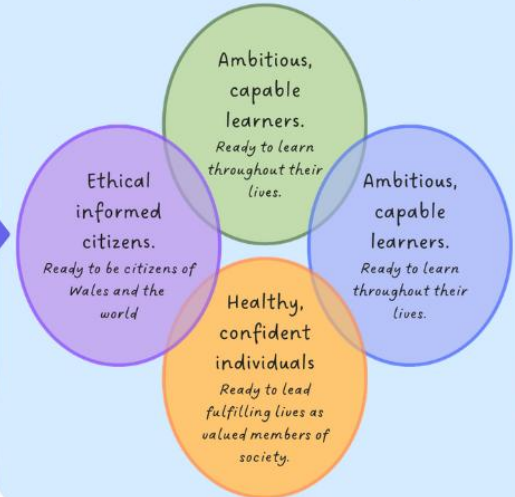

Context for Learning: Superheroes and Rio De Vida

Superheroes!

As part of our learning, we will explore fictional superheroes as well as real-life superheroes. Children will get a chance to share who their real-life superhero is and create a piece of artwork about them. We will learn about people who keep us safe and explore ways to stay safe online.

Children will get chance to explore a variety of comics and even have a go at creating their own. They will design a setting, characters, add speech and thought bubbles and even try using onomatopoeias in their work!

They will also be completing learning linking with their senses and exploring what it means to have a balanced diet. We will learn what we can do to grow strong and stay fit and well!

Describe position, direction and movement.

Know left and right.

Learning Welsh vocabulary and sentence patterns including learning new songs and vocabulary.
