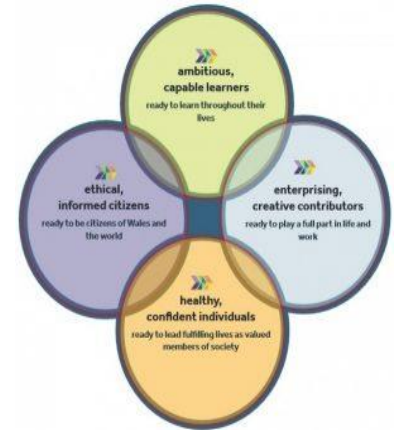

Context for Learning: Frozen Kingdom (Our Wonderful World)

Language, Literacy and Communication: Video blog and diary entry written by Captain Scott, Haiku poetry based on a polar landscape / Iorek Byrnison, creating a guide to exploring the Polar region and writing a chronological report based on the Titanic / Icebergs. Reading of Northern Lights by Phillip Pullman (class book and graphic novel)

Mathematics and Numeracy: Enterprise project, creating and selling an item for a polar based charity, create and modify stock for an Arctic exploration, use coordinates, angles and distances to plan an Arctic exploration, draw conclusions from a range of data linked to polar exploration and to justify One World focus.

Health and Wellbeing: Healthy food and its impact on the body, creating food based on food taken on the voyage, keeping safe online, fitness development.

Expressive Arts: Taking photos of the local area, create painting / soundtracks of the Northern Lights, investigate art of the Inuits and recreate our own. Also, creating a dance linked to polar region.

Science and Technology: Internet safety, continue investigation of light and how animals interact and adapt to their environments, create an information video about the Polar region, create a snow plough / vehicle.

Humanities: Why did people want to explore the Polar region? Who was Captain Scott and what can we find out about his journey from Cardiff?
