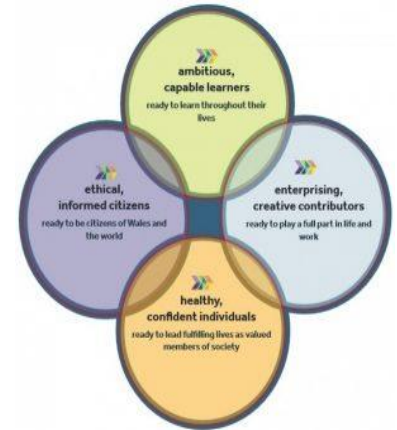

Context for Learning: A Child's War (World War 2)

Language, Literacy and Communication: Write a diary entry from the perspective of an evacuee, write a story based on the Home Front, persuade people to grow their own food or make do and mend via poster or radio advert.

Mathematics and Numeracy: Budget for a family linked to rationing, measure ingredients for a World War recipe, solve mathematical problems linked to the Home Front, calculate the number of casualties for each country, compare the land size for different countries, compare different tanks in terms of size.

Health and Wellbeing: Healthy food and its impact on the body, creating food based on WW2 recipes and ingredients, try rationed food, create a WW2 drill / dance linked to the Home Front / War.

Creative Arts: Singing wartime songs and creating art linked the Blitz, creating a dance linked to combat.

Science and Technology: Developing class website with WW2 research, researching information about WW2, properties of light linked to the blackout, sending coded messages, make an animation linked to the Home Front, design an underground bunker

Humanities: Where did World War 2 take place and which countries were on each side? Who were the main leaders of the countries and what can we find out about them?

During the Week:

New home learning activities will be uploaded onto Google Classroom.

Each week will either have a numeracy or literacy focus. Homework will need to be completed by the Friday of each week unless otherwise stated.

Children will need to be reading at home regularly with their own book and those allocated on Active Learn.
