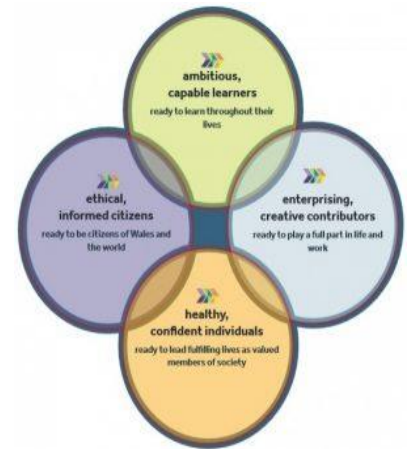

Context for Learning:

During this term, we will be learning through our themes of 'Tribe' and 'Festivals & Celebrations'.

Who lived in the Iron Age? What kind of people were they? Explore these questions and more in this special project about the Iron Age Celts of Wales. In this project, children will explore: who the Celts were and when they lived, how they lived, Celtic customs, beliefs and traditions and what happened to the Celts. This will include exploring different clay techniques, which they will use to make and decorate a Bell Beaker-style pot. Through this theme, children will also explore the scientific world of forces and magnetism, metals and materials.

Through our theme of 'Festivals & Celebrations', children will explore religious and non-religious festivals which celebrate light including Christmas and Hanukkah. We will also consider light scientifically looking at different sources. As well as preparing an exciting Christmas performance, children will also take part in the Christmas Enterprise project.
