Context for Learning:

During this term we will be learning through our themes of Movers & Shakers and Celebrations

The Movers & Shakers Context teaches children about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. They will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.

Language, Literacy and Communication: Reading and spelling words phonetically and by sight, developing letter formation and handwriting, consolidation and use of basic punctuation (capital letters, full stops) and moving onto exclamation marks, extending sentences using adjectives, verbs and adverbs, writing stories / letters / fact files / poems / reports / accounts. Reading and writing in Welsh, using familiar and learnt sentence patterns and vocabulary. Learning some Italian vocabulary and simple sentence patterns in order to talk about themselves.

Mathematics and Numeracy: Place Value (TU / HTU / ThHTU), addition and subtraction (bonds to 10, 20 and 100, multiples of 10) then using place value, doubling - up to double 15, 2D shapes – describing and sorting, multiplication – 2-, 5- and 10-times tables, ordinal numbers, length (cm and m), money – counting in 2p's, 5p's and 10p's and making different amounts.

Health and Wellbeing: Warm up games, gymnastics, improving performance, healthy eating habits and food groups, New Beginnings.

Creative Arts: Violin lessons, exploring colours, creating artwork using a variety of media and exploring the work of famous artists, poetry performances.

Science and Technology: Using ICT to find and present information including pictures and graphs, saving and retrieving work, materials and their properties, scientific investigations.

Humanities: Finding out about significant people from the past: Emmeline Pankhurst, Vincent Van Gogh, Neil Armstrong, Rosa Parks and Christopher Columbus to name but a few, Christmas customs around the world.
