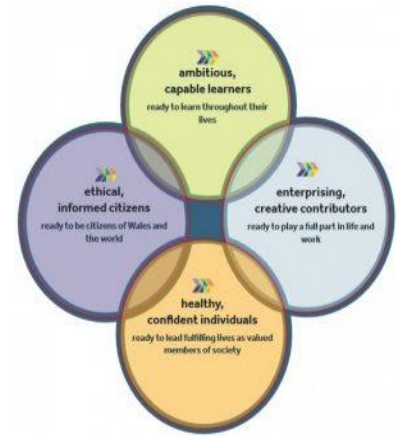

Context for Learning: Victorians. Children of the Revolution.

Language, Literacy and Communication. Developing cursive handwriting. Empathetic writing. Developing balanced arguments. Learning and applying figurative language.

Mathematics and Numeracy. Place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems in context. Decimal place value, linking to units of measurement.

Humanities. Interpreting geographical sources; Chronology and timelines; Primary and secondary sources; Role of men, women and children; Poverty; Reform.

Expressive Arts. This project teaches children about art and design by focusing on the designer William Morris. They explore different ways to present and interpret the artistic elements.

Health and Well Being. Cooking and exploring healthy choices. Well-being games and activities. Physical sports and short games. CCFC workshop. Growing up and changes (RSE).
