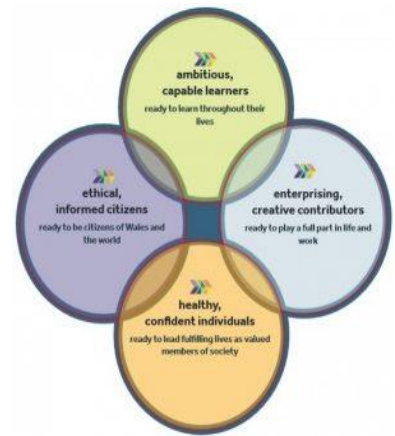

Context for Learning: Sow, Grow, Farm.

This project teaches children about the features and characteristics of land use in agricultural regions across the world, including a detailed exploration of significant environmental areas.

Language, Literacy and Communication- Making choices Non-chronological reports; Diaries; Leaflets; Balanced discussions.

Mathematics and Numeracy- Volume, capacity, area and perimeter within context. Planning to scale a mini allotment. World climatic regions and temperature.

Humanities- Land use, maps of farming regions around the world, climatic zones, mapping using grid references. Types of crops grown around the world.

Science and Technology- Food chains and webs; Life cycles; Plant reproduction; Growing plants and planning a mini allotment. Spring bulb Investigation and data collection. RSPB watch.

Expressive Arts- Class assembly performance. Still Life. Exploring texture when using a range of skills and materials.

Health and Well Being. Outdoor learning. Trip to the local allotments. Healthy eating and seasonal produce. Exploring healthy recipes. Cooking.
