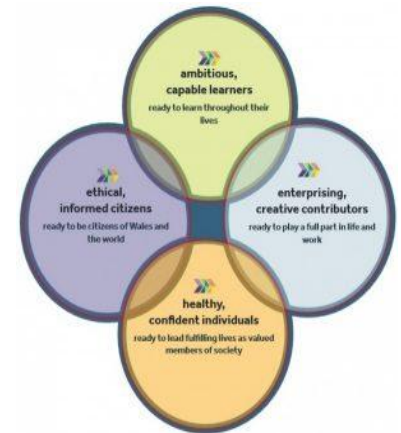

Our Planned themes this term are:

'Healthy body Healthy Mind':- , Keeping fit and healthy, The farm, Teeny Tiny Things

In our themes we will learn about:

- food and farming and explore themes, including where food comes from, what plants and animals need to grow and survive and what constitutes a healthy lifestyle.

This term we will be welcoming new children into morning Nursery session. We will be helping the new children get to know each other and form relationships. The children will learn the everyday routines in the Nursery and establishing expectations for good behaviour.

Our Priorities for this term -

Younger Nursery children will be:

- Learning how to take turns, share and listen to others through role play and weekly 'Circle time sessions in small groups;
- Practising oral counting to 10 and touch counting to 5;
- Learning lots of songs, rhymes and poems;
- Enjoying lots of practical play based activities to develop their personal and social development.

Older Nursery children will be:

- Preparing for their transition to Reception by: taking part in infant assemblies in the school hall, welcoming the Reception teacher for visits and story time;
- Developing their understanding of number and learning to recognise and record them,
- Practising scissor and pencil control and learning to write their name;
- Working on their ability to **hear** rhyming words, sounds at the beginning of words and taking part in fun listening activities.

Together we will be:

- Taking care of the Nursery garden;
- Taking it in turns to serve each other at snack time;
- Learning to say please and thank you in Welsh and to request using 'Ga i...';
- signing whilst singing nursery rhymes and communicating.

We would like your help with:

- Sending snack money in promptly at the beginning of the term,
- Making sure that your child is appropriately dressed for outside activities :
waterproof, sun hat, sun cream applied before arriving at nursery and an extra layer in case it gets cold!
- Making sure your child is holding a pencil, crayon or scissors correctly if doing craft activities at home.
- Ensuring correct letter formation when helping your child write their name—bad habits are very difficult to break!
- Reading stories to your child regularly, to bring back story book from school every Friday to be changed.
- Please ensure your child wears suitable clothing e.g. leggings/joggers and footwear for PE on Thursdays.
