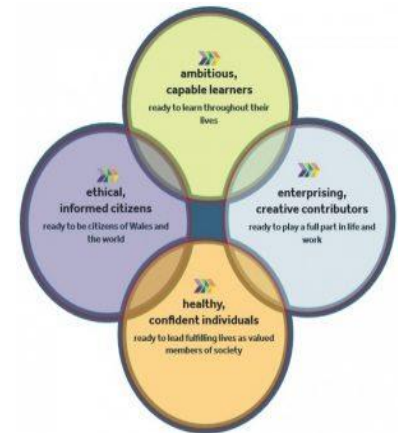

Our Planned themes this term are:

‘Big Wide World:- winter wonderland, signs of spring and ‘Festivals and Celebrations: Chinese New Year/Luna New Year, St. David’s day and Easter.

In our themes we will learn about:

- about the changes that happen during winter, including the types of weather associated with winter. Explore places that have snow all year round and the types of animals that live there.
- about the global community to which they belong and explores how living things, communities and climates differ around the world.
- How to sequence movements to sound and music.
- Mark making, drawing and emergent writing.
- Using Welsh phrases in the indoor and outdoor environment.
- exploring water, including floating and sinking, freezing and melting, and why it is important for living things to stay hydrated.



We would like your help with:

Encouraging your child's self-help skills e.g. putting on their own coat and hanging it up, independent toileting and hand washing. Please send your child to Nursery in clothing which is appropriate to help facilitate this;

Making sure your child has a warm/waterproof coat (labelled with name)—we use the outdoors in all weather conditions!

Reading stories to your child regularly, to bring back story book from school every Friday to be changed.

Please ensure your child wears suitable clothing e.g. leggings/joggers and footwear for PE on Thursdays.

This term we will be welcoming new children into morning Nursery session. We will be helping the new children get to know each other and form relationships. The children will learn the everyday routines in the Nursery and establishing expectations for good behaviour. We will also support children to

- Learn how to take turns, share and listen to others through role play and weekly 'Circle time' sessions in small groups;
- Learn lots of traditional, nursery and modern rhymes and songs
- Use the outside to learn about seasonal changes and how to plant, grow and tend to the garden;
- Learn/consolidate colour recognition and ability to count orally to 10/20

We are working to further developing skills:

- Maths: counting forwards and backwards to 10 from a given number, recognising numbers; counting groups of objects and matching with numeral; recognising and naming shapes; using mathematical vocabulary such as more and less.
- Literacy: listening to stories and answering questions about the text; retelling stories; identifying sounds, rhyming words and syllables; experiment with mark making and develop fine motor skills.
