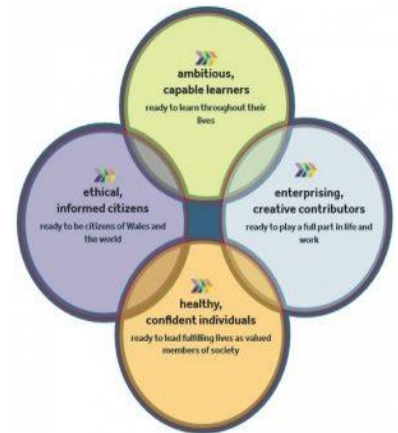

Our Planned themes this term are:

'Me and long ago?', 'Exploring Autumn', 'Sparkle and Shine' and 'Festivals and Celebrations: Christmas'

In our themes we will learn about:

- Ourselves, our families, likes and dislikes;
- The names of different parts of the body;
- Seasonal change - Autumn
- How to sequence movements to sound and music;
- Mark making, drawing and emergent writing;
- Using Welsh phrases in the indoor and outdoor environment;
- Explore materials that are man-made, natural, shiny and reflective;
- Experiment with making shadows using a light source;
- How light is important in a range of different celebrations;
- The traditions of Christmas.
- Pupil voice – following the children's interests.



We would like your help with:

Encouraging your child's self- help skills e.g. putting on their own coat and hanging it up, independent toileting and hand washing.

Making sure your child has a warm/waterproof coat (labelled with name)—we use the outdoors in all weather conditions!

Make sure that your child's jumpers and cardigans are labelled with their names, it is difficult to give them out at the end of the session if they are not labelled.

Singing songs and rhymes and reading stories to your child regularly.

Please ensure your child wears suitable clothing e.g. leggings/joggers and footwear for PE on Thursdays.

This term we will be

- Helping the children get to know each other and form relationships
- Helping the children learn the everyday routines in the Nursery and establishing expectations for good behaviour:
- Learning how to take turns, share and listen to others through role play and weekly 'Circle time' and 'Wellbeing' sessions in small groups;
- Learning lots of traditional, nursery and modern rhymes and songs
- Using the outside to learn about seasonal changes and how to plant, grow and tend to the garden;
- Learning/consolidating colour recognition and ability to count orally to 10; in Welsh and English
- Using a range of assessments to get to know your child's skills.
