## WHAT IF MY CHILD IS UNWELL?



- We know that there are more illnesses around at this time of year.
- However, children with mild illnesses, like a cough or cold without a fever, **can often still attend school.**
- The NHS guidance Is my child too ill for school? helps you make informed decisions.

## WHEN TO SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL

- Cough or cold without a temperature
- Sore throat without a temperature
- Cold sores
- Conjunctivitis
- Head lice and nits



## WHEN TO KEEP YOUR CHILD OFF SCHOOL

- Diarrhoea and vomiting - you child needs to stay home for 48 hours after the last episode
- Chicken pox
- Measles
- High temperature
