## Year 2 Visit to Penarth Lifeboat Station

They were fascinated to hear about the different rescues and to see the equipment used by the lifeboat team. The children also took part in learning how to stay safe in and around the water, including what to do in an emergency and why it is important to follow safety advice when visiting the beach.

After the visit to the lifeboat station, the children enjoyed exploring the nearby beach, observing the natural environment and talking about what they could see along the shoreline. It was a fantastic opportunity to link classroom learning with real-life experiences.
