Sun Safety at Bryn Deri Primary School

Let's enjoy the sun safely. Here is how we can work together to protect our children and make sunny days at school fun and healthy.

What Parents and Carers Can Do



Apply Sunscreen Before School:
Use SPF 15+ on exposed skin each morning.



Head Wear
Please provide pupils with a labelled hat to protect them from the sun



Pack Sunglasses:
Protect their eyes with UV-blocking sunglasses.



Provide Labelled Water Bottles
Ensure children bring water bottles to school and they are washed regularly

What We Do in School



Supervise Sunscreen Application by older pupils



Provide Shade:
Our playgrounds have designated shaded areas for breaks and learning.



Education:
Staff will teach children about the importance of keeping safe in the sun



Keep Hydrated:
We provide access to fresh water and remind children to drink regularly.



Important Note:

Please note that school staff are unable to apply sunscreen to children. Please ensure your child arrives with protection applied.

By working together, we ensure children enjoy outdoor learning and play safely while building healthy habits for life.
