Sun and Water Safety

On Monday, our assembly focused on sun safety—ironically while heavy rain thundered on the roof! It was a good reminder that keeping safe is important whatever the weather.

We talked about simple ways to stay safe in the sun, such as wearing hats, using sunscreen, and drinking plenty of water.

We also highlighted the importance of water safety, especially following the tragic news over half term when hot weather led to the loss of 15 young lives across the UK.

Using guidance from the Royal Life Saving Society (RLSS), children learned to:

- Stop and think about risks
- Stay together
- Float if they get into difficulty
- Call 999 or 112 in an emergency

We encourage families to continue these conversations at home—these small reminders can make a big difference in keeping children safe.



Year 5 Pedal to Success

This week, our Year 5 pupils have been developing their cycling safety skills—and what a fantastic effort they put in! Despite some very challenging weather conditions, the children showed great determination and enthusiasm throughout the week.

During their sessions, pupils learned key skills such as stopping safely, using clear hand signals, navigating obstacles, and maintaining good awareness of their surroundings. As their confidence grew, many children had the opportunity to take their learning beyond the school grounds, cycling around the local streets and putting their skills into practice in real-life situations.

Every child impressed us with their positive attitude and commitment. No matter their starting point, all pupils made excellent progress over the four days, growing in both skill and confidence.
